## **In Memory**

**Remember someone special and contribute to the ongoing work at Remus Memorial Horse Sanctuary, saving animals from cruelty and providing them with ongoing care.**

Remus Memorial Horse Sanctuary is set in quiet countryside and can provide a lovely setting to remember a loved one, as well as providing a safe and peaceful sanctuary for horses, ponies, donkeys, sheep, goats, cows and cats that have been victims of physical or mental abuse, as a result of ignorance or malicious intent.

We can provide several ways in which to pay tribute to a loved one, be that for a friend, family or for a much-loved animal.



## Field of Memories

Our Field of Memories enables you to set up a memorial fund in the name of someone you have lost, this fund can then be added to by friends and family over the years. Often people like to continue to mark special occasions such as Birthdays, Christmas or significant dates and this provides a great way to keep memories of your loved one alive through contributing to the on going work at Remus. You would be notified every time a donation was made in the name of your loved one.



## **Funeral Service**

Some people prefer to have collections at a funeral or memorial services in place of or as well as flowers.

We can provide pew envelopes or collection boxes for a forthcoming service to yourselves or a funeral director. Or you may want to set up a Just Giving Donate In Memory page and selecting Remus Memorial Horse Sanctuary as your chosen charity.



## Memory Bench

There are various sites around the Sanctuary where a bench may be placed in memory of a loved one. They provide a place for quiet contemplation and an opportunity to take in our beautiful surroundings.

A plaque with your loved one's name is put on the bench to create a lasting memorial.

Once installed you would be invited to the Sanctuary to see the bench in place.

The Sanctuary will ensure that it is maintained and kept in good order for its natural life.

## Hedgerow of Remembrance

We have planted 1000 hawthorn bushes at the Sanctuary to create a Hedgerow of Remembrance, and your loved one could become part of that. It also provides natural shelter for the animals in our care, allowing them to self medicate, and offers food and shelter for the wildlife and birds that call the Sanctuary their home.

For a donation of £40 a loved one can be remembered within this hedgerow. As part of the Hedgerow your loved one will be added to our online Book of Remembrance where you can write your own memories or just have their name, you will also receive a certificate for you to keep.



## Memory Wall

Loved ones can be remembered on our Memory Wall, a 10x6inch slate plaque will be placed on the side of our main stable block overlooking the small orchard.

The wording reads 'In Memory of ..... “

The cost of a plaque is £60.00

Once in place you would be invited to the Sanctuary to come view your plaque.





## Memorial Garden

We now have a memorial garden at the Sanctuary, which has become a quiet haven for the wildlife and for people to sit quietly and reflect. It can be arranged for ashes of a loved one to be scattered here.

Human - £200

Animal – £100





## Specific facility Funding

If you would prefer to donate to something specific at the Sanctuary in honour of a loved one, we can dedicate one of our stables, paddocks or field. We would provide an engraved plaque that would be placed on the chosen stable, shelter or gate to the field.

Stables – £500  
Paddock/field - £1000



## **Sponsorship**

Many of our supporters sponsor an animal and receive a certificate with a picture of their animal. Sponsorship can be purchased in memory of someone that has passed and this would be acknowledged on the certificate.

Sponsorship is £25 a year.



## **Memorial Day**

Once a year we invite the families of those who have donated to Remus in memory of a loved one to a short service where their names are read out. This event provides an opportunity for friends and families to gather for an informal afternoon, enjoy refreshments, see the plaques and spend time in the Memorial garden.
